3.0.0 Discussion papers

3.0.1 ATM and Bus Stop Windwardside

As planned an ATM space along with a Bus Stop will be built near the future ING Bank. Three quotes were received. The lowest quote was chosen and CF Construction was given the job. The work will be overseen by Project Manager and Assistant Trainee from the Infrastructure and Spatial Development department.

An ATM space along with public restrooms will be built near the gazebo in The Bottom. Three quotes were received. The lowest quote was chosen and Luis Construction NV was assigned the job. The work will be

3.0.3 Cove Bay Playground Contract

Over the past year, an inclusive process was undertaken to develop the design for the Cove Bay playground. Input was gathered through multiple sessions with students, as well as consultations with the Cove Bay board. The resulting preliminary design received strong positive feedback from both the students and the board. A townhall meeting was also organized to present the design and invite public input; although no residents attended, the information was subsequently shared via press release to ensure transparency.

The project has since progressed to the implementation phase. Playground equipment has been ordered, with the first shipment arriving on March 18, 2026, and a second container expected in early June 2026. Construction is planned to commence in June, in line with the delivery of materials.

Quotations were requested from several local contractors. While some contractors declined and others submitted significantly higher bids, CCD was identified as the most suitable and cost-effective option to execute the works.
